

## Appendix

### Categories publications 2016

#### Cat. 1 Dissertation/Ph-D thesis

A dissertation/Ph-D thesis is describing the results of a scientific research project, performed by a doctoral candidate. The purpose of the dissertation is to get a doctoral degree. The dissertation should be focussed on the profession and should be bibliographically traceable.

A further subdivision is suggested in:

Dissertation at own institute and also prepared at own institute (di;1A);

Dissertation at own institute but prepared elsewhere (de;1B);

Dissertation elsewhere but prepared at own institute (dv;1C);

Dissertation elsewhere and prepared elsewhere (dz;1D);

Hybrid, for example at collaborating institutes (dm).

#### Cat. 2 Scientific publication in an international journal mentioned in SCIE or SSCI (wi-1)

This refers to a scientific publication published in an international journal. The publication (wi-1) is an international bibliographical traceable description of results of scientific research, published as an article in a journal, focused on the scientific community, among other things proved from the scientific status of the journal. The journal has to be mentioned in the most recent (Social) Science Citation Index (Expanded) (SCIE or SSCI) of Journal Citation Reports (JCR). It has to be noted that the height of the impact factor, as mentioned in these lists, is not relevant here. Only the fact that the journal has an impact factor matters.

A review article in an international journal with impact factor is also considered as an international publication.

#### Cat. 3 Scientific publication in an international journal (wi-2)

This refers to a scientific publication published in an international journal. The publication (wi-2) is an international bibliographical traceable description of results of scientific research, published as an article in a journal, focused on the scientific community, among other things proved from the scientific status of the journal.

#### Cat. 4 Editorial Material (edit)

This refers to a publication in an international journal (bibliographical traceable) that is published as Editorial Material.

#### Cat. 5 Letter to the editor (le)

This refers to a refereed communication in an authoritative international scientific journal. The letter needs to be reviewed.

Cat. 6 Scientific publication in a national journal (wn)

The journal has to work with a referee system. This category is particularly important for those fields (clinical, general practice, psychosocial) where the practising national professionals have to be informed of scientific developments on the concerning field. In general, it concerns publications written in Dutch.

Cat. 7A Book (bk)

The book has to be a scientific publication, provided with an ISBN number. The bibliographical information must indicate whether it is a matter of a 'full book' or a 'contribution to a book' (see category 7B).

Cat. 7B Book contribution (bb)

A book contribution is part of a scientific book (for example introduction and/or chapter(s)). Both the details of the book and the concerning chapter need to be provided.

Cat. 7C Congress paper/proceedings paper (pp)

A congress paper/proceedings paper is as such presented on a congress and published in an international (scientific) journal.

A congress abstract, whether or not published in an (international scientific) journal, will be ignored considering the publications.

Cat. 8A Patent pending in 2016 (oca)

Patents as far as they represent the results of scientific research.  
Category 8A refers to a patent which is applied in 2016 but not yet awarded.

Cat. 8B Patent newly awarded in 2016 (ocb)

Patents as far as they represent the results of scientific research.  
Category 8B refers to a patent which is applied in 2016 or earlier but has to be awarded in 2016.

Cat. 8C Patent total amount of current patents in 2016 (occ)

Patents as far as they represent the results of scientific research.  
Category 8C refers to the total amount of current patents in 2016 (excluding the patents which are newly awarded in 2016 as mentioned in category 8B).

Cat. 9 Professional publications (vp) national and international

The purpose of a professional publication is to distribute knowledge among professionals in the field. This category of articles is mostly published in a general oriented journal or a non-specialist journal. Reviews of non-specialist books are not included in this category.

Cat. 10 Reports (ra)

Reports whether or not ordered by a third-party (whether or not with an ISBN number).

Note E-publications 'ahead of print' are excluded from any of the above categories.
